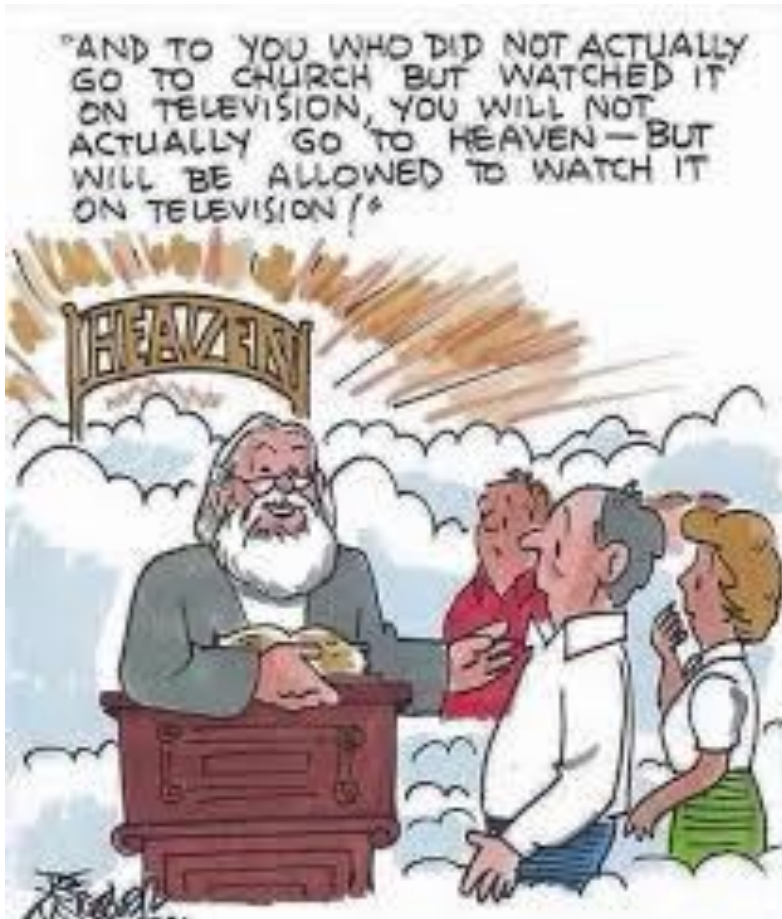

## Blue Card update

**No card, no start:** from 31 August 2020 will mean that paid workers must have a blue card (not just a pending application) before they can start working with children.

People with paid applications in progress when the policy starts can continue working while their application is assessed.

Volunteers, trainee students and people running regulated child-related businesses already need a blue card before they can start working with children.

If you don't apply to renew your card before it expires, you will be subject to the no card, no start policy and will not be able to continue working or volunteering until a new blue card has been issued.

The Synod office will undertake the necessary changes in relation to emails we send to ministry agents to reflect the changes about renewing a blue card prior to expiry.
