At our Congregational Meeting last Sunday;

After 16 years' service as treasurer and on Church Council, Wayne has resigned, and Neville, after 17 years' service as Chairman, and on Council, has also resigned.

In recognition of their hundreds of hours of service, and as a final thankyou, Allan proposed a worship service (date still to be set) to recognize their contributions and their commitment, to us.

And for us to approach him respectfully to ask if there's anyway synod can meet with us and offer help with, for example- mowing etc, or slacken the rules... at least till Covid is over.... So we can keep going as a church.

Other topics:

Is there an option to merge with Nambour, and have $\frac{1}{4}$ of a minister? Or with other churches, as in the past or to at least find out if there are any other options. Can Wesley Mission help us, since we sold the manse to fund WMP? Etc

Wayne said he would continue to pay the Bills for now..

We also voted the whole congregation, temporarily, on to the Church Council.

Jan R and Allan have agreed to give 1st and 3rd Sunday services. Meg will do the music on the 1st, and Jess on the 3rd. No Communion yet.

Can we apply for council grant as a charity/ not-for-profit entity?
How many other churches are in the same pickle?

Our church is over supplied with spiritual growth. What we need is an input of other gifts.

Keep praying. The angel of change/hope may have been delayed, but is still on his way.
