We held Our congregational meeting last Saturday .

Chairman Ian had a dental emergency, and Allan stepped in heroically, and cleared the way for Chris Crause, Phil Smith and Dave Thomas to help us understand our current situation, and possibilities for continuing worship at Maroochydore U/C.

Phil likened our situation to Abram (when God said to him "let's go to a new land"), and Nehemiah (when the remnants of God's people needed to work together to repair the city walls). Phil emphasised that like them, we can't do this on our own.

Kris explained the bigger picture, and forwarded a few possibilities, one being that we might be able to re-classify as a faith-community, and Phil stressed the need to move forward slowly, and review where we stand around June 21st 2021. And there might be the possibility of yard work being done for us.

Ian arrived, and amazingly transfigured from his role as dentist, straight into Chairperson mode. The key question posed was *Do we want to continue as a*


congregation? With the responsibilities this requires. Our finances remain an issue. And Phil offered to help us create a priority list.


We still need to organise a date for thanking Wayne and Neville for all their service to us over the years.
