Do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand. *Isaiah 41:10*

To succeed you need two things: (1) *The right people.* Sometimes the first step towards getting out of discouragement is finding somebody who can lift you. When you spend time with someone who is continually negative and full of despair about their life, you can come out of that conversation feeling negative and full of despair at your life too. The company you keep will either lift you up or pull you down. Paul wrote, 'God, who comforts the downcast, comforted us by the coming of Titus'. You need a Titus in your life, and you need to become a Titus to others. Galations 6:2 says 'Bear one another's burdens'. (2) The right perspective.
