shared as First and Second Peoples in Christ.*

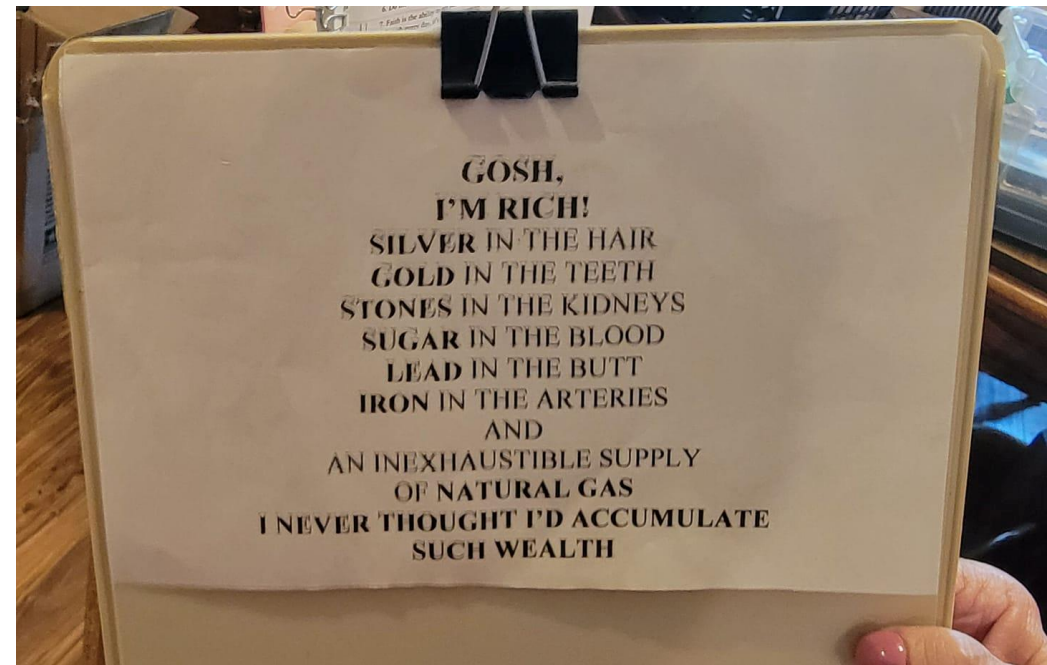
*Challenge our blindness, our misconceptions, our ignorance,
