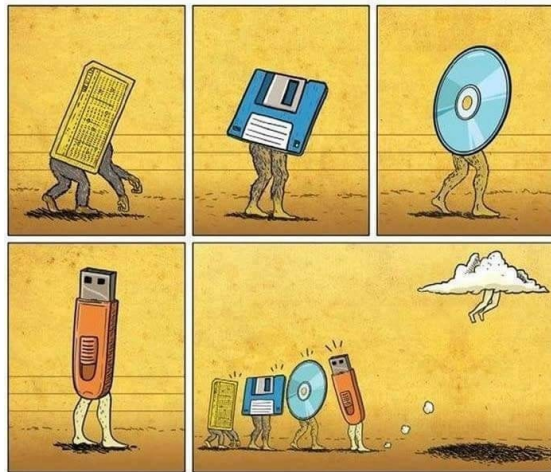

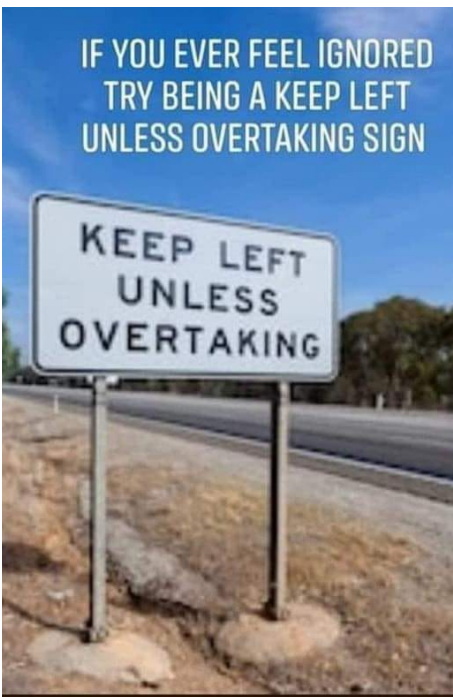

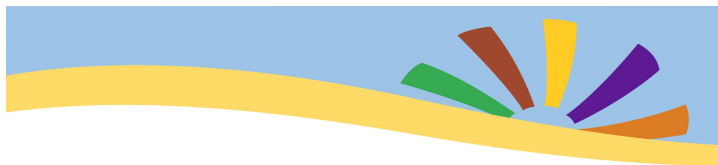

### **A Trip to Change Your Life** , from **The Moderator**, Rev Andrew Gunton

I don't know if you have ever set out on a business trip or even a holiday thinking that it will change your whole life. Normally we are just looking to get on with the business at hand or, in the case of a holiday, looking for some time out from the every day, but if I think about it, my most memorable vacations were, in fact, the ones that made me stop and think about the direction my life was taking. These were the trips that made me stop and think, made me realise how fortunate I was, what it was that I took for granted or maybe just stop and think about how beautiful this planet really is. A great trip, be it a holiday or business, is one that forces us to make some changes in our lives when we return, maybe it's a simple change in the way we thought about a place or the people we encountered, but maybe it's as profound as coming back and changing our job.

Saint Paul, that prolific New Testament writer, was on an ordinary business trip as he set out on the road to Damascus. He does not expect to encounter the risen Christ, who comes and turns his world upside down and puts Paul on a very different course for the rest of his life. A life that was to be spent in the proclamation of the living God.

Are we prepared to be confronted on our journey through life? Are we listening to the risen Christ and how he might call us in new directions, new possibilities in order to best use our gifts and abilities and, in doing so, serve Christ and serve the world.
