A Trip to Change Your Life , from The Moderator, Rev Andrew Gunton I don't know if you have ever set out on a business trip or even a holiday thinking that it will change your whole life. Normally we are just looking to get on with the business at hand or, in the case of a holiday, looking for some time out from the every day, but if I think about it, my most memorable vacations were, in fact, the ones that made me stop and think about the direction my life was taking. These were the trips that made me stop and think, made me realise how fortunate I was, what it was that I took for granted or maybe just stop and think about how beautiful this planet really is. A great trip, be it a holiday or business, is one that forces us to make some changes in our lives when we return, maybe it's a simple change in the way we thought about a place or the people we encountered, but maybe it's as profound as coming back and changing our job.
