

"Before Hid glorious presence without fault". (Jude 24)

Think about that wonderful phrase, "without fault". "We're far off from it now, but since our Lord never stops short of perfection in His work of love, we'll reach it one day. The Saviour who will keep His people to the end, will also present them at last to Himself, "as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless." All the jewels in the Saviour's crown are of the highest quality and without flaw. But how will Jesus make us without fault? He'll wash us from our sins in His own blood until we're white and fair as God's purest angel. We'll be clothed in his righteousness righteousness that makes the saint who wears it positively without fault, perfect in the sight of God . We'll be blameless and unreproveable even in his eyes. His law will not only have no charge against us, but it'll be magnified in us. Moreover, the work of the Holy Spirit in us will be altogether complete. He''ll make us so perfectly holy we'll have no lingering tendency to sin. We'll be holy even as God is holy, and we'll live in His presence forever. Saints won't be out of place in heaven, their beauty will be as great as that of the place prepared for them. Oh, the rapture of that hour when the everlasting doors will be lifted up, and we who have been made fit for the inheritance, will live with the saints in light. Sin gone, Satan shut out, temptation past forever, and we ourselves "without fault" before God – that's heaven indeed!
