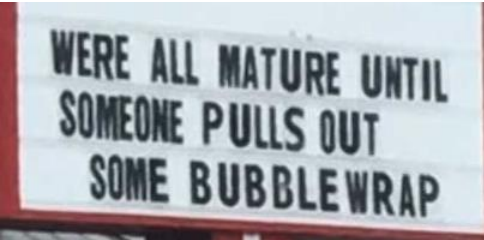


Finally settling down to my vegan, gluten free, soy free, antibiotics free, raw, non GMO, organic, fat free, low carb meal!

2 Corinthians 7:2 “defraud no man”

Theme: Dishonesty
