GOD IS ON HIS THRONE

The Lord reigns forever.

PSALM 9:7

God's answer for troubled times has always been the same: heaven has an occupied throne.

During the eighth century BC, ancient Judah enjoyed a time of relative peace, thanks to the steady leadership of Uzziah, the king. Uzziah was far from perfect, yet he kept the enemies at bay for fifty two years.

Then Uzziah died. Isaiah the prophet, who lived during the reign of the king, was left with ample reason for worry. What would happen now that Uzziah was gone?

Or, in your case, what will happen now that your job is gone? Or your health has diminished? Or the economy has taken a nosedive? Does God have a message for His people when calamity strikes? He certainly had a word for Isaiah. The prophet wrote: "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple" (Isaiah 6:1 NKJV).

Uzziah's throne was empty, but God's was occupied. He was, and is, alive, on the throne, and worthy of our endless worship.
